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Notice concerning the Initiation of Electric Power Sales at the Large-Scale Solar Energy Power Plant at Minamishimabara City, Nagasaki Prefecture

This is to give notice that on September 13, 2013, the large-scale solar energy power generation facility constructed previously at Minamishimabara city, Nagasaki prefecture (disclosed in the "Announcement: Land Secured for Mega Solar Power Plant by Fixed Asset Lease," dated June 21, 2013) has commenced electric power sales following the scheduled end of the power supply agreement with Kyushu Electric Power Co., Inc.

1. Purpose

Since the enactment of the "Act on Special Measures Concerning the Procurement of Renewable Energy by Electric Utilities" in July 2012 and the introduction of fixed-price sales regulations for renewable energy, the Company has been engaged in the development and construction of large-scale solar energy power generation facility projects. Electric power sales at the large-scale solar energy power plant referred to in this notice are expected to enhance the earnings of the Company, in addition to the plant's extraordinary significance as a social contribution to resolving electric power shortages and providing environmental relief.

Notably, the plant's current energy output is 49 kW, ultimately scheduled to be raised to the scale of 1 megawatt (1,000 kW).
